A new warehouse!

Caterham Foodbank are delighted to announce we have a new warehouse!

In 2013 when Caterham churches set up Caterham Foodbank our storage space was adequate for our needs, but as the project has grown and we've been able to support more people in Caterham and the surrounding area, the space quickly became too small. At the beginning of 2020, even before the Covid-19 pandemic hit, it became an urgent situation. We're grateful to Tandridge District Council for identifying a suitable facility for us which we've now had renovated, and so been able to move to much larger premises. All the lovely donations we receive can now be stored much more efficiently, and our volunteers are able to work in a much better environment.

We'd like to say a huge 'thank you' too, to the 4 Rotary clubs in Tandridge, who have generously donated money to turn the space into a warehouse. They not only donated the money but their time too in fitting all the shelving and DIY jobs before moving in, a great job and much appreciated!

As a Christian charity, our lack of storage space was a situation we prayed about, and we believe God answered those prayers, and praise Him for this provision.





Covid-19 Update

We're beginning to see more restrictions on our daily lives rather than less, and so sadly not much has changed since our last newsletter in this regard. The foodbank continues to help those in financial need and unable to afford food. Not surprisingly in these circumstances, in the last 6 months many more people have needed help and support from us, and we expect to give out record numbers of food parcels this winter.
