Thankfully the worst of the virus seems to be behind us however the impact will continue to be felt for a while. We are now able to engage more with users of our Foodbank again, offering them tea a listening ear and signposting them to other services alongside supplying them with food.

Although life is gradually returning to normal the need for our service isn't diminishing. It rose an additional 10% last year (having already increased 125% for 2019-2020) and we are expecting it to continue

to rise due to the increase in fuel prices and the cost of living. As our number of users increase we are also currently seeing a fall in donations. This could be for a number of reasons but may just be that less people are in a position of being able to help.

The war in the Ukraine is tragic and seems far removed from us by distance although close to our hearts, however this will also affect local economies and could impact the need further.

We have been very blessed by our community donations in 2021 both food and financial, large and small, by corporate companies and individuals. We were busy in November as usual preparing to distribute Christmas Hampers and were grateful again to the Caterham, Oxted and Godstone Lions for supporting these. Despite things not starting smoothly with the boxes we needed to pack failing to be delivered on time and then turning up soaked due to the rainstorm; everyone worked really hard and 372 hampers were packed, collected and delivered. These were so gratefully received by many in our community.

Thank you to all the volunteers who worked so hard to get them ready on time.
